

# Monifieth High School

## 1:1 Digital Learning – Home School Agreement



Monifieth High School will provide every learner with a Chromebook and a range of digital learning tools and resources to assist and enhance their learning at school and at home. The initiative is often referred to as 1:1 Digital Learning.

All pupils and parents/carers must read and understand all statements of the terms and conditions outlined below:-

	<b>Parent/Carer Agreement</b> <b>I agree to my child having the use of a Chromebook on these terms.</b> <b>I will:</b>
1.	ensure that my child cares for and respects their Chromebook.
2.	immediately report any loss or theft which happens out of school, firstly to the police and then to our School Office. An incident number should be obtained from the police.
3.	ensure that the Chromebook is used by only my child out with school hours.
4.	ensure that the Chromebook is returned if my child leaves school, or at any other time upon the request of a senior member of staff.
5.	allow the school to apply appropriate sanctions for misuse of the Chromebook.
6.	monitor my child's use of the Chromebook online at home, to ensure that only appropriate websites and services are accessed.
7.	pay a refundable responsibility charge of £15 over the next 3 years.
8.	make a contribution to repair/damage.

<b>School Agreement</b>	
<b>We will:</b>	
1.	provide all S1 learners with a Chromebook, charger and access to a range of digital learning resources.
2.	provide all learners with a range of learning opportunities which will make use of the Chromebook, both in school and at home.
3.	provide parents/carers with ongoing advice/training to help them support their child's use of their Chromebook.
4.	ensure that the Chromebook is working and that any repairs are dealt with as quickly and effectively as possible.
5.	give pupils an introduction to using and caring for the Chromebook. This will include a session on security, digital safety, maintenance and health & safety.
6.	provide wireless access to the Internet across all areas of the school site. Provision will be made after school to allow learners to complete homework/carry out research using the Internet if required. The school will not be responsible for any costs involved, nor content accessed, when the Internet is accessed out of school.
7.	regularly monitor and evaluate the use of 1:1 Digital Learning with learners and their families.

<b>Pupil Agreement</b>	
<b>I agree to using my Chromebook on these terms.</b>	
<b>I will :</b>	
1.	always look after my Chromebook
2.	ensure that my Chromebook is sufficiently charged for school each day.
3.	always keep my Chromebook in the case provided by the school and store it in an appropriate school bag when not in use. During lunchtimes, I will store my Chromebook in my locker and not leave outside.
4.	only use my Chromebook in class, school library or at at home– never in the playground, unless participating in outdoor class activities.
5.	only use my Chromebook in lessons when instructed by my teacher and close it or put it away when instructed.
6.	only use software on my Chromebook that my teacher has agreed I can use in the lesson.
7.	ensure I have the permission of everyone concerned before using the Chromebook to record audio or video clips.
8.	not access inappropriate content on my Chromebook.
9.	not remove any security markings nor allow it to be the subject of graffiti.
10.	not remove any software that have been installed by the school.
11.	immediately report any damage, loss or theft to Mrs Perry (PT PC&S) or School Office.
12.	only use the supplied Chromebook charger.
13.	report any technical problems to a teacher.
14.	ensure that all work stored on the Chromebook is regularly backed up to Microsoft Office 365 OneDrive.
